The Volnay Mitans from the new micro-négociant Les Parcelles de Saulx has showy aromas that reflect the maturation in 30% new casks. Behind the oak, however, lurks a pleasantly ripe blackberry fruit with floral and earth notes. The texture is fairly firm for the appellation, with grippy tannins and a slightly astringent edge. This should open up nicely with a few years in bottle, however, and would be perfect for mid-term ageing.

This lovely village-level wine is made from a single parcel located on the other side of the Route des Grands Crus. The ripe apple fruit aromas are supplemented with butter, hazelnut, and spice notes. The texture is lush and ripe but balanced by the vintage's fresh acidity. The parcel is located at the base of the slope in fairly deep clay soils; it has delivered a wine that is ready to drink and should hold well for the next five years.
