

## Parcelles de Saulx

### White

**2022, Meursault Pré de Manche, Parcelles de Saulx** ..... ★ ★ ★ ★ 89-91

A similar mid lemon colour. A plot with old vines, speaks of Meursault yet with energy. Good acidity at the back, and fair length. A little extra roundness. Drink from 2026-2030. Tasted: October 2023.

**2022, St-Aubin En l'Ebeaupin, Parcelles de Saulx** ..... ★ ★ ★ ★ 89-91

Mid lemon yellow. A light but pleasing nose, this has had a bit of lees stirring which one can see in the yeasty element on the nose, then kicks on with a linear energy, some fresh pears as well as apples, a little citrus wash behind, typical of its location Drink from 2026-2030. Tasted: October 2023.

**2022, Monthelie Les Duresses 1er Cru, Parcelles de Saulx** ..... ★ ★ ★ ★ 90-91

2022 will be the only vintage of this wine, as the vineyard has gone to Domaine Belleville from 2023. Mid lemon yellow. Some weight on the nose without detail. A little rounder and deeper here, with significant energy, ripe grapefruit, good body and fine length. Drink from 2026-2030. Tasted: October 2023.

**2022, Pernand-Vergelesses En Caradeux, Parcelles de Saulx** ..... ★ ★ ★ ★ 89-91

A clean incisive lemon colour. The nose also is a little more chiselled but then a weight of riper fruit behind, with a saline touch behind the ripe fruit, shows its hillside location. Drink from 2026-2030. Tasted: October 2023.

### Red

**2022, Monthelie Longennes, Parcelles de Saulx** ..... ★ ★ ★ ★ 87-90

2022 will be the only vintage of this wine, as the vineyard has gone to Domaine Belleville from 2023. The sample was taken before racking this morning. A fresh vigorous purple. Here the oak is slightly taking the upper hand over this lighter bodied, indeed quite elegant Monthelie. I think this will sort itself out. Tannins as much from the wood as the wine. Drink from 2027-2031. Tasted: October 2023.

**2022, Aloxe-Corton Fournières 1er Cru, Parcelles de Saulx** ..... ★ ★ ★ ★ 88-90

The darker side of purple. Quite a dour nose, dark fruit again, dark currants before they become raisins. Livelier on the plate, attractive fruit with some intensity, and slightly ruder tannins behind, in the manner of Aloxe- Corton. Drink from 2027-2032. Tasted: October 2023.

**2022, Gevrey-Chambertin Evocelles, Parcelles de Saulx** ..... ★ ★ ★ ★ 90-92

Not as deep in colour as the Aloxe, with corresponding additional finesse on the nose. A few oak tannins behind, but there is a fine boned and fresh fruit to cover the structure. Good finish. Drink from 2027-2032. Tasted: October 2023.

**2022, Clos Vougeot Grand Cru, Parcelles de Saulx** ..... ★ ★ ★ ★ 93-95

A dark purple, even across the glass. A heady bouquet of raspberries, rather successful. The oak sits well with this too. Just a touch of sandalwood here, but there is a lively energy of a very dark raspberry fruit, some tannins and quite good length. Drink from 2029-2036. Tasted: October 2023.
