
RICH AND COMPLEX

-THIS "CLIMAT"

"Morgeot" is based on the Gallic word "Morga", which means "border, frontier". The "Morgeot" Climat is located on the border between the Côte d'Or and Saône-et-Loire départements.

- Terroir

Situated halfway up the slope this Climat is formed of soil that is predominantly clay and limestone.





TASTING

Appearance: Very attractive pale gold

Bouquet: Delicate and subtle, notes of honey, vanilla, almond and fresh hazelnuts with a floral hint of broom and hawthorn and pear fruitiness.

In the mouth: Rich with notes of hawthorn, honey and pear, spicy with peppery notes, saline finish.
