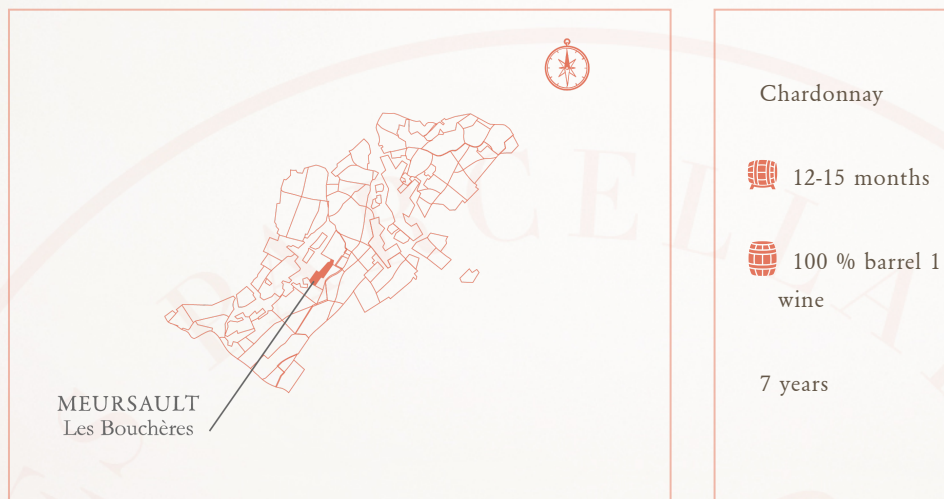
THIS "CLIMAT"

In Meursault, this climat is below the climat "Chaume des Narvaux" which was fallow at the time.

In old French, "Bouchères" means a place planted with boxwood and brushwood. The proximity of this climate to a land with scrub explains its name.

TERROIR

A clay-limestone terroir exposed to the South, South East with a ground made up of blond soil, very steep and very stony



TASTING

Colour : clear and golden

Nose : an intense and subtle nose with notes of white flowers

Mouse : this wine is mineral and silky with aromas of fresh fruits and fine spices and a complex and elegant finish.
